

PSI CHAPTER CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE POLICY

In accordance with the national policy as well as the University policy on controlled substances, the Psi Chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi at University of California, Los Angeles adopts the following policy, specifically designed to fit the unique experiences and standards of our Chapter.

1. An event shall be considered official anytime an individual is acting in the capacity of a Chapter member (defined as any active, conditional, probationary, candidate, or alumnus of the Psi Chapter) at an event expressly associated with Kappa Kappa Psi (including the visible wearing of any fraternal insignia, pamphlets/fliers showing the fraternal insignia, or events discussed in Chapter meeting or over Chapter listserv).
 - 1.1. For Chapter trips affiliated with Kappa Kappa Psi including, but not limited to, State Days, DLC, and Conventions, each particular travel group shall be given official start and end (departure and return) times that the event will be considered official, including all downtime between “gavel-to-gavel.”
2. If any Chapter member is seen, heard, or smelled as being under the influence of, in possession of, or consuming a controlled substance, said member will be considered in violation of this policy. All events are considered to carry equal grounds for consequences.
 - 2.1. If an active or conditional member shows up to an event already under the influence of a controlled substance, there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on suspension.
 - 2.1.1. If the motion to suspend does not pass, immediately following there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on probation.
 - 2.2. If an active or conditional member is found in possession of or consuming any controlled substance at an event, there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on suspension.
 - 2.2.1. If the motion to suspend does not pass, immediately following there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on probation.
 - 2.3. If a probationary member shows up to an event already under the influence of, is found in possession of, or is found consuming any controlled substance, there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on suspension.
 - 2.4. If a candidate member shows up to an event already under the influence of, is found in possession of, or is found consuming any controlled substance, there shall be an automatic motion made to expel said member from the New-Membership Education Process, per 6.2.9 in the Psi Chapter Constitution.
 - 2.5. If an Alumni member shows up to an event already under the influence of, is found in possession of, or is found consuming any controlled substance, said member will be asked to remove oneself from the event, and may, at the discretion of the Chapter and/or Chapter Sponsor, not be invited to future Chapter events.

3. Any band trip (planned/paid for by the UCLA Bruin Marching Band) shall not be considered an official Kappa Kappa Psi trip. However, Chapter members attending said trips still must abide by the stated band policy.
 - 3.1. If an active or conditional member is found to be in violation of the stated band policy, there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on suspension.
 - 3.1.1. If the motion to suspend does not pass, immediately following there shall then be an automatic motion made to put said member on probation.
 - 3.2. If a probationary member is found to be in violation of the stated band policy, there shall be an automatic motion made to put said member on suspension.
 - 3.3. If a candidate member is found to be in violation of the stated band policy, there shall be an automatic motion made to expel said member from the New-Membership Education Process, per 6.2.9 in the Psi Chapter Constitution.
4. This Controlled Substance Policy must be amended at a regularly scheduled Chapter meeting by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all active members of the Chapter.
